WHAT IS A STRONG DELEGATION?

A strong Flood the Hill delegation includes:

- Engagement Lead (assigned by NAFTAE) – coordinates the state team and anchors the effort
- Adult Learners – share lived experience
- Educators/Staff Members – connects program impact
- Workforce Partners or Employers – validates workforce/economic impact

The most effective delegations represent the full impact of adult education—from classroom to career.



BUILD YOUR DELEGATION

1. Commit as the lead
2. Identify 2–3 learners who are ready to share their story
3. Invite one partner/employer
4. Confirm your team
5. Register for Flood the Hill

HOW TO CHOOSE THE RIGHT PEOPLE

Strong Learner Fit:

- Comfortable sharing their story (not perfect—just willing)
- Reliable and responsive
- Represents your program/state well

Strong Partner Fit:

- Understands your program
- Can speak to hiring, skills, or workforce gaps
- Has a clear connection to adult education outcomes
